Transgender is defined as a person whose gender identity doesn't match the sex they were assigned at birth



FINDINGS



Around 110 out of 4700 universities in US cover hormone replacement therapy

33.3% of transgender, genderqueer or intersex students concealed/modified their gender identity or gender expression when interacting with their campus health practitioner



POLICY RECOMMENDATIONS

 Identify the accessibility of starting or continuing HRT use at each UNC System University

 Conduct a Campus Climate Survey focused on sexual orientation, gender identity, and gender expression at each UNC System institution
