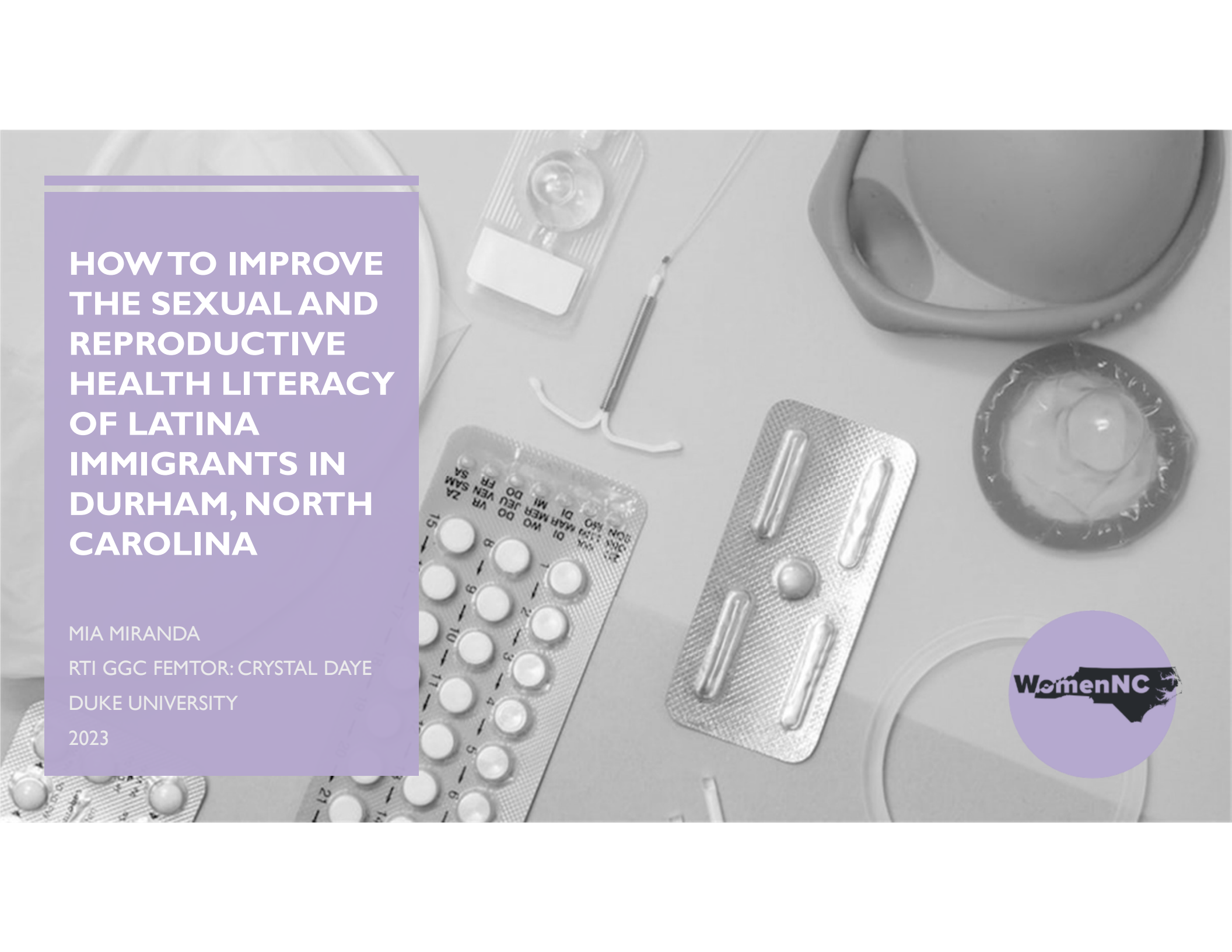

- STIs, HIV, Cervical Cancer

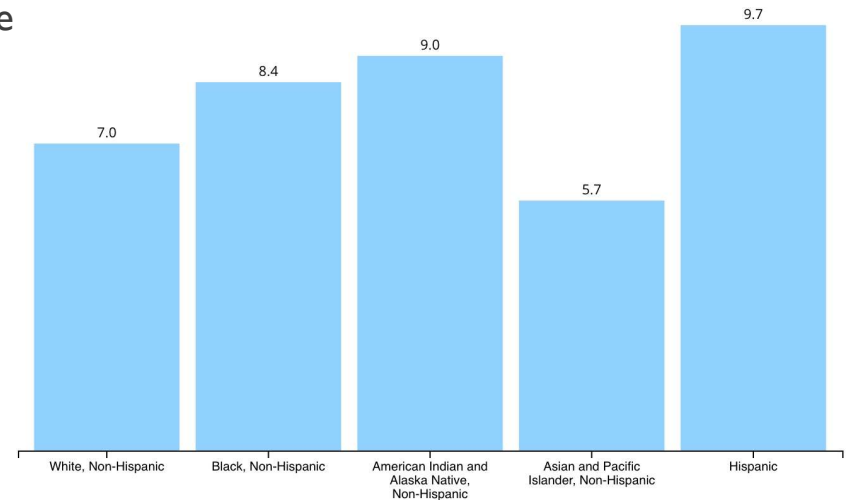
Fertility

Trauma

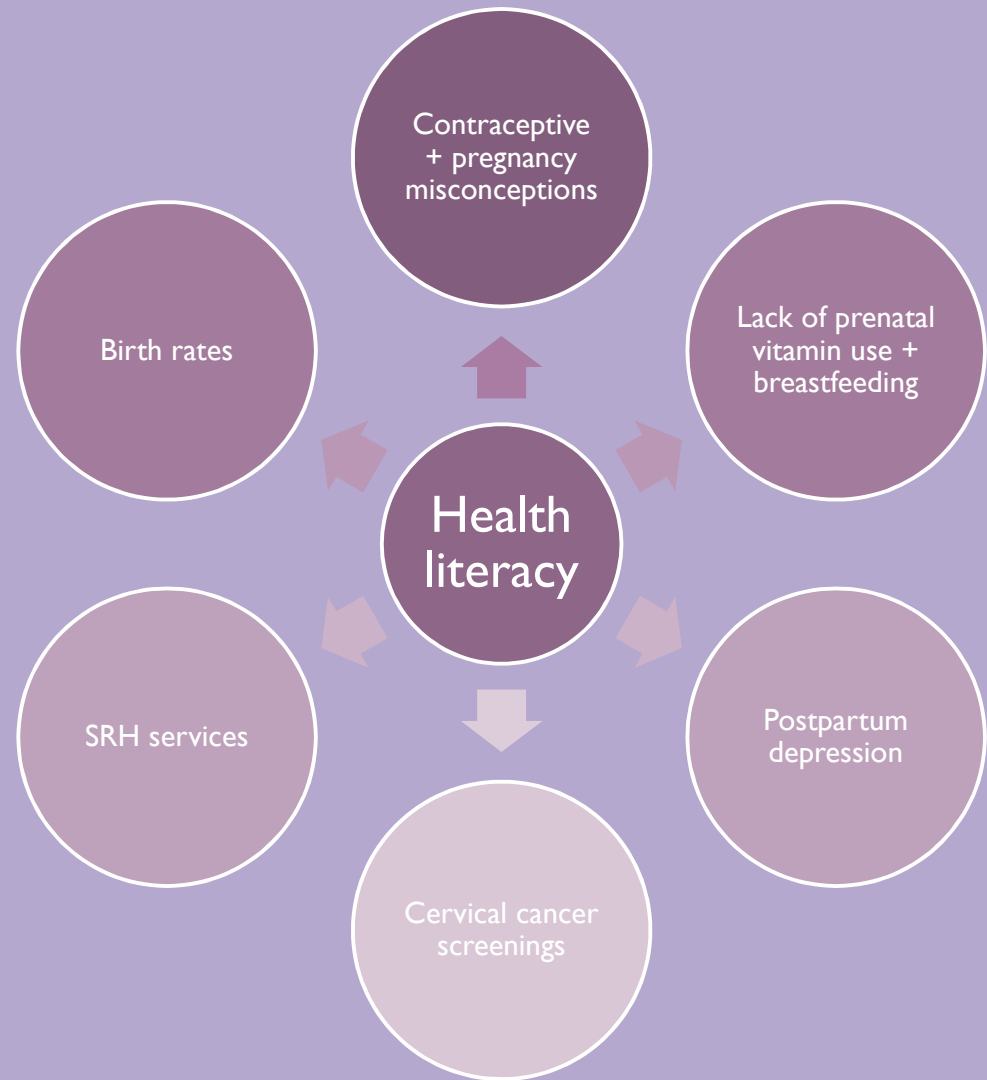
- Reproductive Coercion, Sexual Trauma, IPV

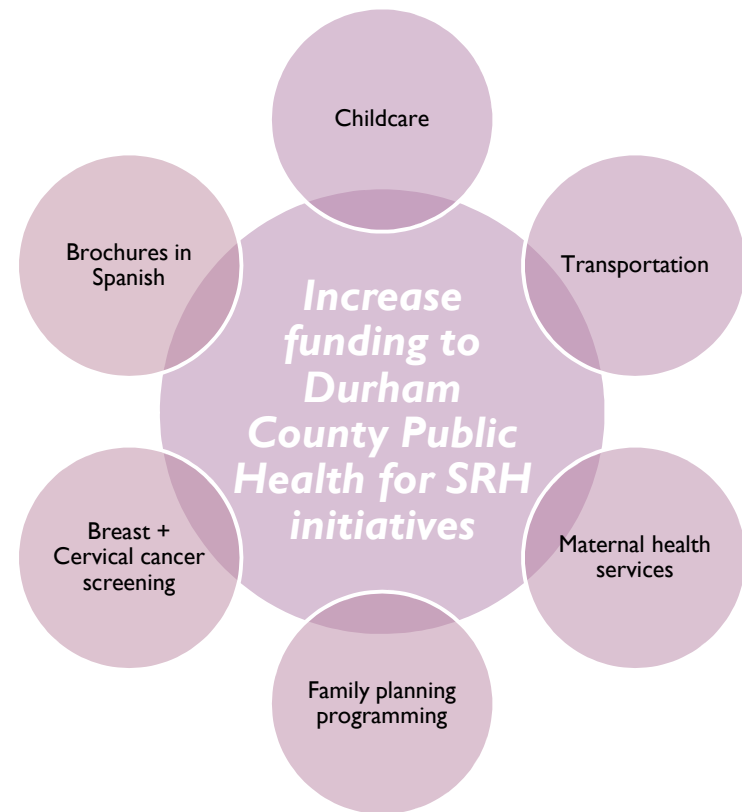
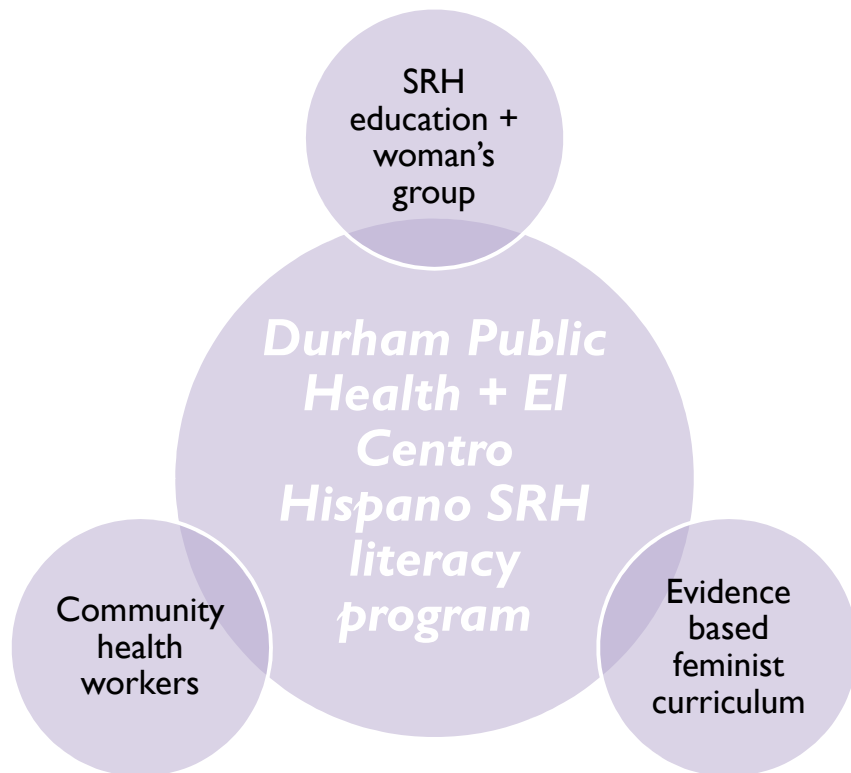
